Abstract

Various theories have been emerged in The contemporary period in order to analyze literary texts and their relationship with socio-cultural elements. One effective approach for analysis of literary texts is critical discourse analysis. In This Thesis, critical discourse analysis has been chosen based on Norman Fairclough's method. He analyzes a text in three levels: description, in terpretation and explanation. Thos method is effective in identifying and explaining ideologic views of authors and Their socio-political opinions and by presenting a new method tries to discover various layers of meaning in a literary work. The present research attempts To analyze novels: "hamsayeh-ha" (1978) by Ahmad Mahmud, and "Asir-e-Zaman" (captured by Time)(1994) by Esmaeil Fasih. Using the above approach and to intrestigate These Two authors' views as two prominent Ficton writers in Iran who p;ayed roles in important contemporary socio-political events. Finally, it was found That Mahmud and Fasih held particular views about political, social and cultural developments and criticized Iran situation at that time. From the critical discourse perspective, after each nouel was investigated, it was found That Mahmud and Fasih opposed The existing discourse by selecting certain words, using historical, mythical, figurative and metaphorical aspects in The structure of each novel.
