## Comparative Analysis of Dimensional Inequality between Iran Central and Border Rural Regions

In this study the collected data and about 224 villages as examples and systematic sampling are selected from province Sistan-Baluchestan, Kurdistan, Hormozgan, Khorasan shomali, Golestan, Tehran, Qazvin, Hamedan, Yazd and Chahar Mahal and Bakhtiari, to analyze the data and compare it with in the three sections 65, 75 and 85 and determine the process changes using the Excel software and models, and scattering coefficient Gini coefficient discussed. research findings indicate that most aspects of social inequality has been allocated to villages in the border regions and the central and central regions increased availability has led to the creation of more opportunities in this area.
